Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year! We hope it is off to a great start.

Are you ready for VCCF 2024? Pre-registration via Google Form opens September 16, 2023 and will close October 16, 2023. Please complete the pre-registration form to reflect a commitment from your school (with approval from your administration) and the number of students. Registration is limited to 15 students (grades 4-6) per VOKE member, and space is limited to the first 150 participants. Once the 150 limit is reached, schools will be placed on a wait list. If a school is not able to honor their commitment, waitlisted schools will have the opportunity to step in and participate. Once registered, fees are nonrefundable for any reason including illness, change of schedule, and weather-related cancellations. The building being used for this event is a public school building belonging to Prince William County Public Schools. Though the weather has never completely canceled our event, we will follow PWCS cancellations and/or delays.

VCCF Audition and Selection Guidelines

In order for a student to be considered for the festival, the student must:

- 1. Be enrolled in a Kodály-based choral ensemble or Kodály-based music class
- 2. Sing consistently in tune with good tone quality and diction
- 3. Demonstrate the ability to read and follow music
- 4. Exhibit strong part-singing skills
- 5. Exhibit good citizenship
- 6. Attend all school and festival rehearsals unless prevented by illness

Teachers must:

- 1. Be VOKE/OAKE members
- 2. Bring a maximum of 15 students This number is NOT a quota to fill, but a limit
- 3. Strive for a selection of participants that positively reflects the spirit and talents of the school or program
- 4. Select only those students who meet the musical and citizenship requirements

**Important note about part splits: Please ensure that Soprano $1 = \frac{1}{3}$ of your singers, Soprano $2 + Alto 1 = \frac{1}{3}$ of your singers, and Alto $2 = \frac{1}{3}$ of your singers. In the case of uneven numbers please place additional students on Alto 2, then Alto 1, then Soprano 2 - no additional student on soprano 1)
